



Dear Salt Lake County Recorder's Office customer,

As a valued customer this notification is to inform you that as a result of recent changes passed during the 2019 Legislative Session HB247 (County Recorder Fee Amendments) standardizes recording fees across the state and mandates this new fee schedule becomes effective **May 14, 2019**.

Beginning **Wednesday May 14, 2019** fees in the Recorder's Office will change as follows:

- Documents submitted for recording (excluding plats) will be charged a \$40 fee with an additional \$2 fee for each description exceeding 10.
- All plats will have a \$50/sheet charge along with a fee of \$2 per lot or unit.

All mail submissions postmarked **May 14 or later** and submissions **received in person after May 13, 2019 at 5 pm** will be considered as received under this new HB247 fee schedule. Our system for **e-recording** will be unavailable while we perform maintenance from 5 pm on May 13, 2019 to 12:01 am on May 14, 2019 to implement these statutory fee changes.
